Other clarifying information:

1. English, American, or World Literature are required to meet the Literature requirement.
2. One English Composition course is required. A second English Composition will not be accepted in lieu of a Literature course, but may count as an elective.
3. These courses must include a "live" lab. Students with science courses taken prior to 2002–2003 will be required to retake one modern Biology and one modern Chemistry course to meet the prerequisite requirements.
4. A lab is recommended but not required for Anatomy and Physiology I and II.
5. A minimum of three semester hours should be in the humanities and the remainder should be in the social sciences, arts, or humanities.
