Other clarifying information:

1. English, American, or World Literature are required to meet the Literature requirement.
2. One English Composition course is required.
3. These courses must include a "live" lab. Students with science courses taken seven years prior to the year of application will be required to retake one modern Biology and one modern Chemistry course to meet the prerequisite requirements.
4. A lab is recommended but not required for Anatomy and Physiology I and II.
5. A minimum of three semester hours should be in the humanities and the remainder should be in the social sciences, arts, or humanities.
